Claudia Mosquera

Claudia Mosquera is a feminist university Professor. She lives in Bogotá, Colombia.

Very young, she wanted to understand why Afros in the Colombian Caribbean were poor, died young and were often murdered.

She studied to become a social worker. In 1988, for a year, she infiltrated a youth gang. There, she collected a lot of information for her studies. She also made friends. When her friends in the gang were killed, she suffered a lot.

Claudia Mosquera thought that if universities did research on violence and poverty in the Afro community, this could help improve their situation. This could put pressure on national and international policies.

So she is always fighting to end violence like racism, sexism, *feminicidio* and poverty.

Today she is one of the most important Professors in Colombia.
