## Gertrude B. Elion, Nobel Prize Winner for Medicine

Gertrude Belle Elion was a US American biochemist and pharmacologist. She was born on January 23 [the 23rd of January], 1918 and she died on February 21, 1999.

In 1988, she received the Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine. She shared it with two workmates, Hitchings y Black. With them, Elion developed new drugs [medicine] using innovative research methods.

Gertrude Belle Elion discovered the AIDs drug, AZT, so she saved a lot of lives! She also developed the first immunosuppressant drug, AZA, for organ transplants and the first successful antiviral drug, ACV, for the treatment of herpes.
